Airport

- Airport T-Hangars have been demolished, asphalt demo is in progress
- Replacement doors for the damaged box hangar are being built

Water & Sewer Department

- Thumb for Water Department backhoe - required for picking up asphalt and concrete slabs.
 - o Add to existing backhoe.
 - o \$3,750 delivered, water department will install.
- Working with Allgeier, Martin and Associates to apply for a SCEAP (Small Community Engineering Assistance Program) to study sewer lines. Grant will be for \$50,000 with a \$10,000 City of Lamar Match (80/20).

Electrical Department

- New heat exchangers for CAT #2 were delivered
 - o Contractor installing dropped the heat exchangers and damaged beyond use
 - o New – replacement heat exchangers have been ordered.
- CAT #5 Head exchange will begin middle of September

Street Department

- Concrete street repairs on square have been completed
- Street repair in front of middle school is complete
- Asphalt contract has been awarded to APAC from Springfield
 - o Asphalt work will begin middle of September

Water Plant

- Lagoon sludge depth measuring and sampling has been completed
- New compressor and air dryer has been installed and is operational

Parks & Rec

- Pool is closed, new cover will be ordered this month (budget item)
- New procedures are in place to winterize the pools

Landfill Generation Facility

- Annual Emissions Testing has been completed on Guascor #1 & #2
- Annual Emissions Testing began today on CAT #1, #5 & #6
- CAT #2 will be tested after installation of new heat exchangers

Baptist Church Walking Trail

- Estimated amount to repair walking trail surface, bridge and washed out areas = \$7,000 (not included in 2019-2020 budget).
