

# City Administrator Notes

## Council Meeting

7/20/2020

### Airport

- Preliminary plans for the taxi lanes have been submitted by Lochner for the T-Hangar Project.
- Lochner is preparing bid packets for taxi way construction. Taxi way construction is scheduled for this fall.

### Water & Sewer Department

- Working with leak detection specialist to locate water line leaks across the City
- Flow meters are being placed in the wastewater collection system around town to monitor flow (part of the SCEAP Grant)

### Electrical Department

- South Substation Transformer is scheduled to be installed approx. July 27. Site preparation has been completed.
- Experiencing small outages due to extreme heat and load.
- Upgraded service to drive-in for new projector.

### Street Department

- 160 bridge is complete – bypass route is no longer in use as a bypass
- Numerous drainage projects in-process through-out the City.
- Street paving for FY 2020/2021 has been completed

### Water Plant

- Lake well pump is being replaced due to reduced capacity of the pump. A new pump is being installed by Flynn Drilling. 100 hp Hitachi Motor and a Stainless Steel Grundfos 5 stage pump are being installed. Pump and installation \$28,500.
- Extended testing is continuing to monitor water quality for chloramine project.
- Lagoon sludge removal project is proceeding as planned.

### Parks & Rec

- Pool attendance continues to be good despite the COVID-19 restrictions.
- Baseball season has ended for the year.
- Mowing has slowed due to lack of moisture.
- Gabriel Roofing donated time and materials for replacing concession stand roof.

### Landfill Generation Facility

- Guascor #3 radiator repairs have been completed. Engine has been operated and flushed. Starting top end overhaul (Potter).
- The hill is running low on gas. We can only operate (3) engines. Republic is working to find the source of the problem.

### TATS

- Daily number of rides are slowly increasing.
