Airport

- Settlement from Insurance provider for damage during May 2019 windstorm has been received.

Water & Sewer Department

Water Plant

- DNR response letter was received 12/7/2020. DNR agreed with City of Lamar plan to convert to well water. Agreements for Service have been signed with Allgeier Martin and Associates to direct and assist with the conversion.
- New SCADA system installation has been completed and is operational at the Water Plant (2019/2020 Budgeted Item).

Parks & Rec

- Tennis court tile surface at Park is being replaced. New tile is being provided by Danny Little.

Landfill Generation Facility

- Emissions testing on Engines CAT #1, #5 & #6 has been completed. CAT #2, Guascor #3 & #4 will be later this year.
- Planning for the rerouting of Republic Services leachate line is on-going. Line will continue south along the outer road instead of going east along 1st Street. New route will tie into the City's force main at the junction of BNSF Railroad and the outer road south of 160 highways.
