SEALED BIDS for construction of Public Water Supply Well #4 for the City of Lamar, Missouri will be received by the City Clerk, Lamar City Hall, 1104 Broadway, Lamar, MO 64759 until 10:00 A.M., Thursday, May 27, 2021 and then publicly opened and read aloud at City Hall.

The work to be performed under this contract generally consists of the installation of a public water supply well, well house, 10" diameter water line, and miscellaneous sitework and appurtenances for a complete and functioning system.

Attention of the Bidder is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed, and that the Bidder must comply with the payment of hourly wage rates, including all fringe benefits, as established by Section 290.210-340, RsMO, as amended in 1993, pertaining to the prevailing hourly rate of wages and including fringe benefits, as established by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri. A copy of the determination is provided within the Supplemental General Conditions.
