

AN ORDINANCE TO SPECIFY THE REQUISITE FEES FOR LICENSES ISSUED UNDER THE LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE AS AUTHORIZED BY STATE LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Lamar, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. Section 4-40 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and shall hereafter provide as follows:

Sec. 4-40. License fees designated.

(a) The annual fees for the licenses required under this article shall be as follows:

(1) For the sale of intoxicating liquor in the original package at retail, the sum of \$150.00.

(2) For the sale of intoxicating liquor in the original package at retail on Sundays between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and midnight, by any person licensed pursuant to subsection (a)(1), the sum of \$300.00 in addition to the license fee prescribed by said subsection (a)(1).

(3) For the sale of malt liquor containing alcohol in excess of 3.2 percent by weight and not in excess of five percent by weight in the original package, the sum of \$75.00. Any person licensed pursuant to this subsection may also sell malt liquor at retail between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and midnight on Sunday.

(4) For the sale of malt liquor at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold, the sum of \$75.00. Any person licensed pursuant to this subsection shall also be permitted to sell nonintoxicating beer. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 4-100, any person licensed pursuant to this subsection may also sell malt liquor at retail between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and midnight on Sunday.

(5) For the sale of malt liquor and light wines containing not in excess of 14 percent of alcohol by weight made exclusively from grapes, berries and other fruits and vegetables, at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold, the sum of \$75.00.

(6) For the sale of intoxicating liquor at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold by a charitable, fraternal, religious, service or veterans' organization exempt from the payment of federal income taxes under section 501(c)(3), 501(c)(4),

501(c)(5), 501(c)(7), 501(c)(8), 501(c)(10), 501(c)(19), or 501(d) of the United States Internal Revenue Code, as amended, the sum of \$450.00, which includes the license described in subsection (a)(1), provided the organization shall have qualified in all ways for a state liquor license under §311.090, RSMo.

(7) For the consumption of intoxicating liquor on premises where food, beverage or entertainment are sold or provided for compensation, where the person operating said premises does not have a license to sell intoxicating liquor, the sum of \$90.00.

(8) For a temporary permit for sale of malt liquor and light wines at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold by a church, school, civic, service, fraternal, veteran, political or charitable club or organization at a picnic, bazaar, fair, festival or similar gathering or event held to commemorate the annual anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence of the United States, pursuant to §311.218, RSMo, the sum of \$150.00.

(9) For the sale of intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises of any resort, as defined in §311.095, RSMo, the sum of \$450.00, which includes the license described in of subsection (a)(1).

(b) The fees for the other licenses required under this article shall be as follows:

(1) For a special permit to conduct tastings of malt beverages, wines or intoxicating liquors as provided in section 4-50, the sum of \$37.50.

(2) For a temporary permit for sale of intoxicating liquor at retail by the drink for consumption on the premises where sold by a church, school, civic, service, fraternal, veteran, political or charitable club or organization at a picnic, bazaar, fair or similar gathering, pursuant to §311.482, RSMo, the sum of \$37.50.

(3) For a temporary permit for the sale of intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises of any resort, as provided in §311.095.4, RSMo, the sum of \$112.50.

(4) For a temporary permit to caterers and other persons holding licenses to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises who furnish provisions and service for use at a particular function, occasion or event at a particular location other than the licensed premises, as provided in §311.485(1), RSMo,

for each calendar day, or fraction thereof, for which the permit is issued, the sum of \$15.00 per day.

(5) For a special license to caterers and other persons holding licenses to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises who furnish provisions and service for use at a particular function, occasion or event at a particular location other than the licensed premises, effective for a maximum of 50 days during any year, as provided in §311.486(1), RSMo, the sum of \$750.00.

(6) For a special license to caterers and other persons holding licenses to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises who furnish provisions and service for use at a particular function, occasion or event at a particular location other than the licensed premises, effective for an unlimited number of functions during the year, as provided in §311.486(2), RSMo, the sum of \$1,500.00.

C. For any license described in the Missouri Liquor Control Law, Chapter 311, RSMo, that is not specified herein, the fee for such licenses shall be one and one-half times the amount required to be paid into the state treasury for such state permit or license.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
