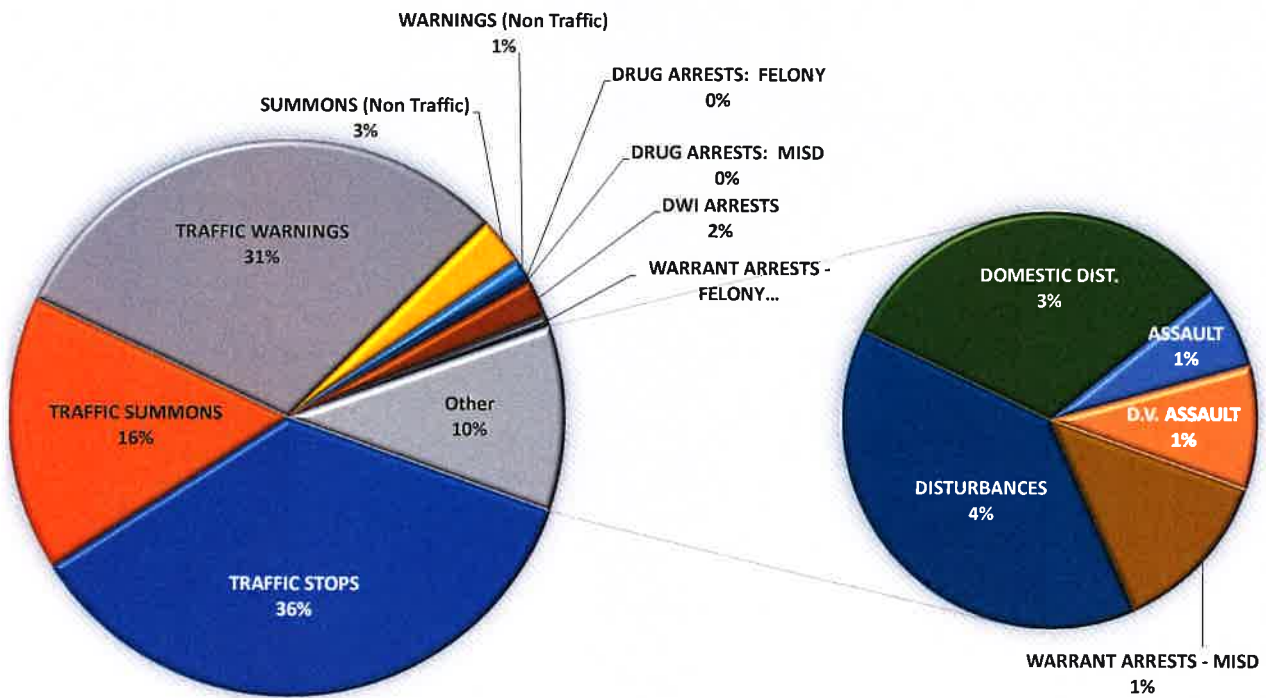


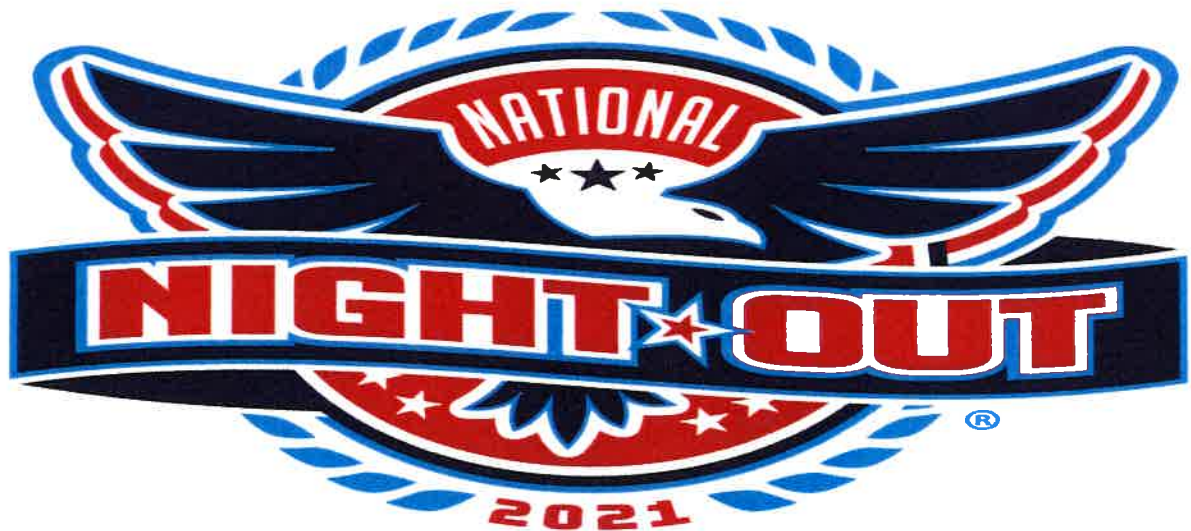

06/21/2021 Officer made traffic stop in park. One person was placed under arrest for receiving stolen property and open container.

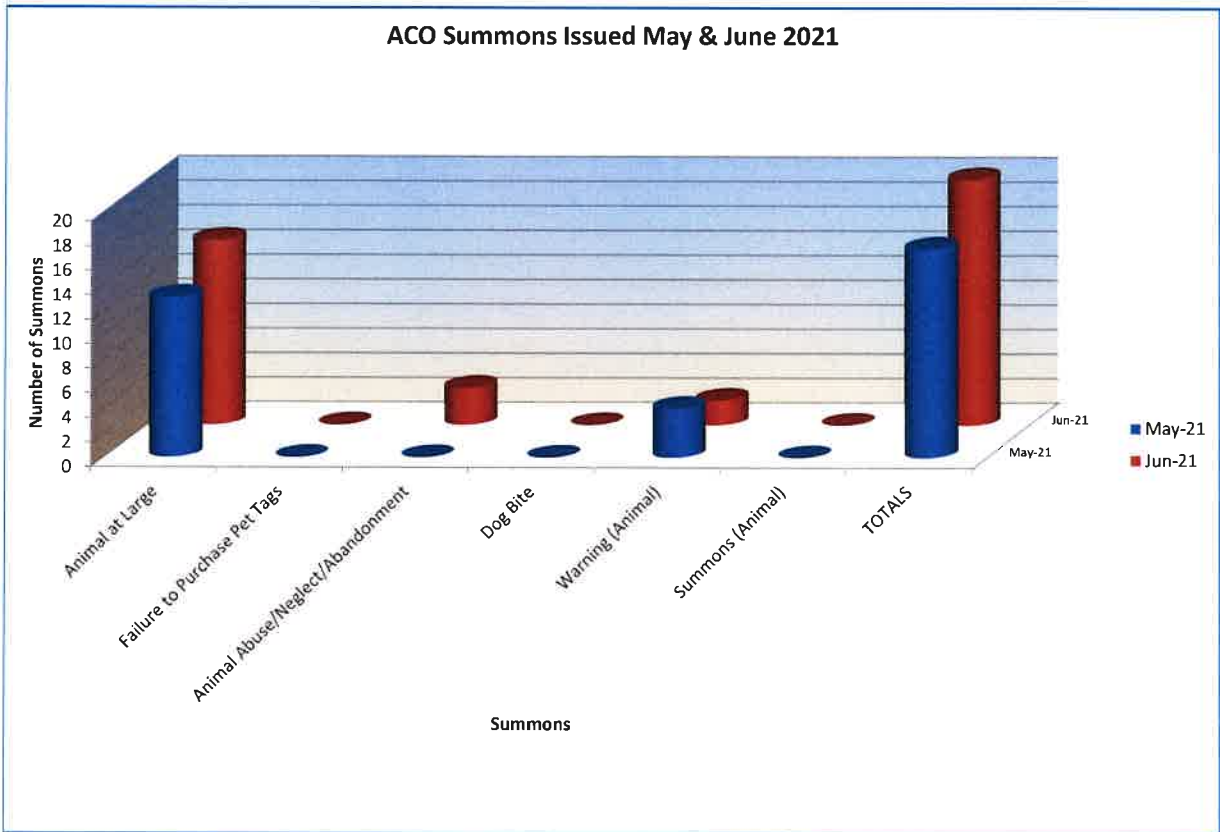

06/28/2021 Officers were dispatched to the 1600 block of College or past tense burglary. Investigation continues.

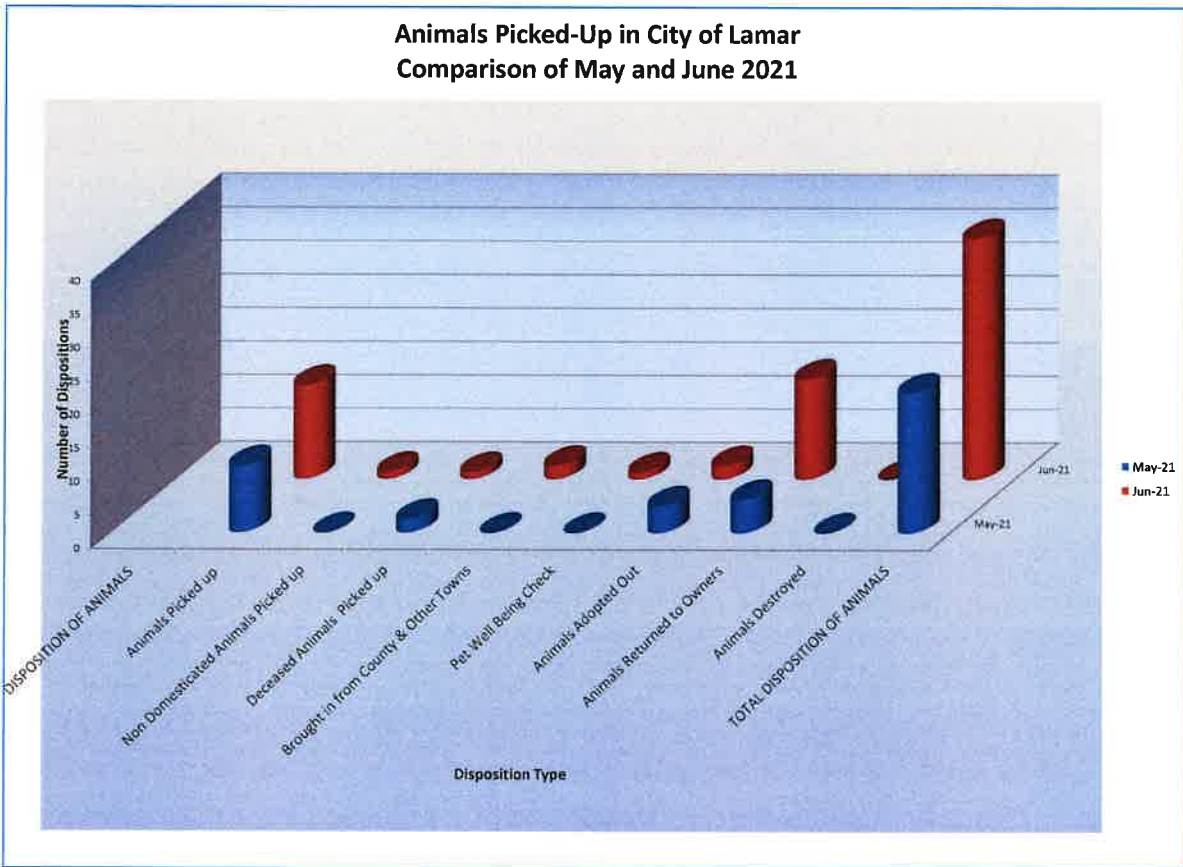
