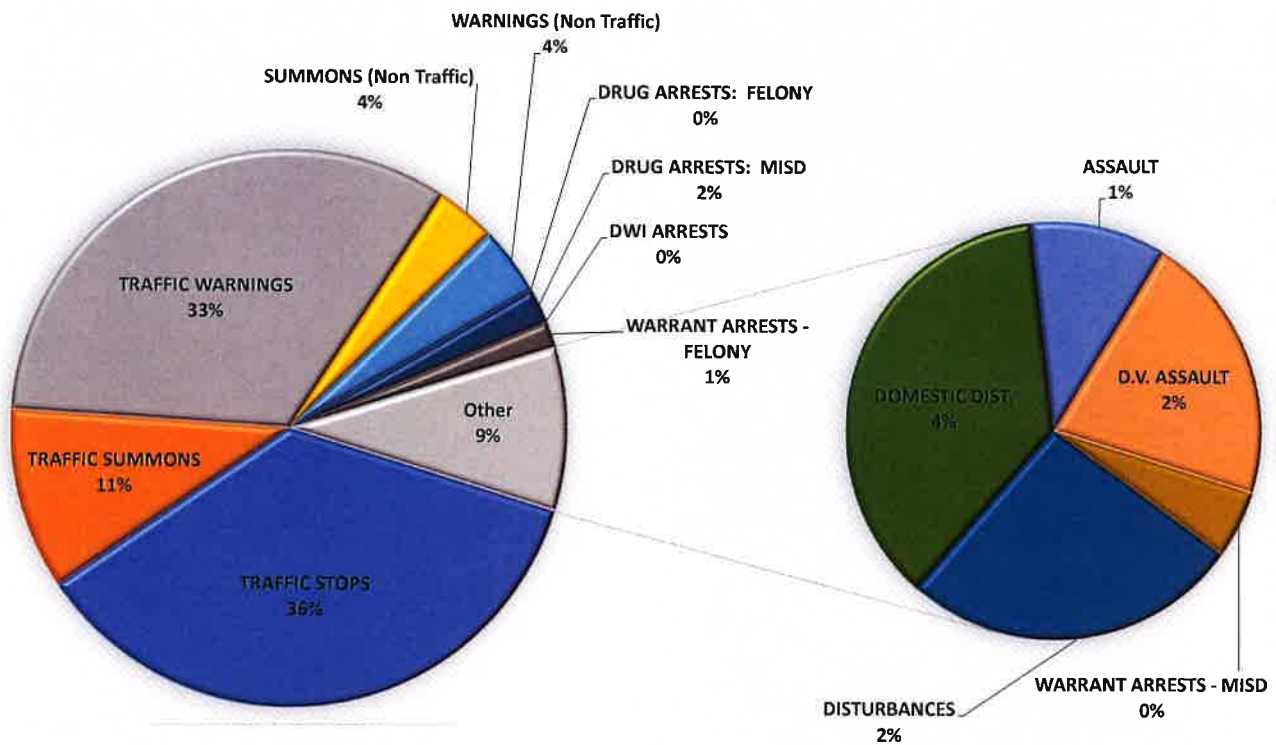

SIGNIFICANT AUGUST EVENTS

Many free haircuts were provided by Ashley Augusta and Cheyenne Dalton of Lotus Salon Studios; also Dylan Maberry and Sam Buzzard from Maberry's Barber Shop.

For the first day of school, we had an officer at the front door of each of the schools greeting the students as they arrived.

The Lamar Fair was a success again. The following police calls were for service related to the fair:

On 08/12/21, at about 08:20am, law enforcement officers from The Lamar Police Department, The Barton County Sheriff's Office and the Missouri State Highway Patrol responded to a call of a robbery in progress at the Community National Bank and Trust in Lamar Mo. Officers arrived as the offender was exiting the bank and he was quickly taken into custody. Rowdy J. Masterson, 50, of Lamar was taken into custody at the scene. The Lamar Police Department submitted charges for Attempted 2nd Degree Robbery, Terroristic Threats and Felony Resisting arrest. Masterson was later formally charged through the Barton County Prosecutor's office; currently Masterson is being held on a no bond warrant. There was not a weapon displayed during this incident and no one from the bank was injured. This incident was ended quickly, and the offender was taken into custody at the scene thanks in large part to the quick, alert actions of the bank staff; we commend them for their response.

8/18/2021 Officers conducted a search warrant in the 1300 block of Gulf. Three people were transported to the Barton County Jail. One was charged with Assault-Police Officer; one was charged with Narcotics-Amphetamine-Possession and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and one was charged with Resisting Arrest.

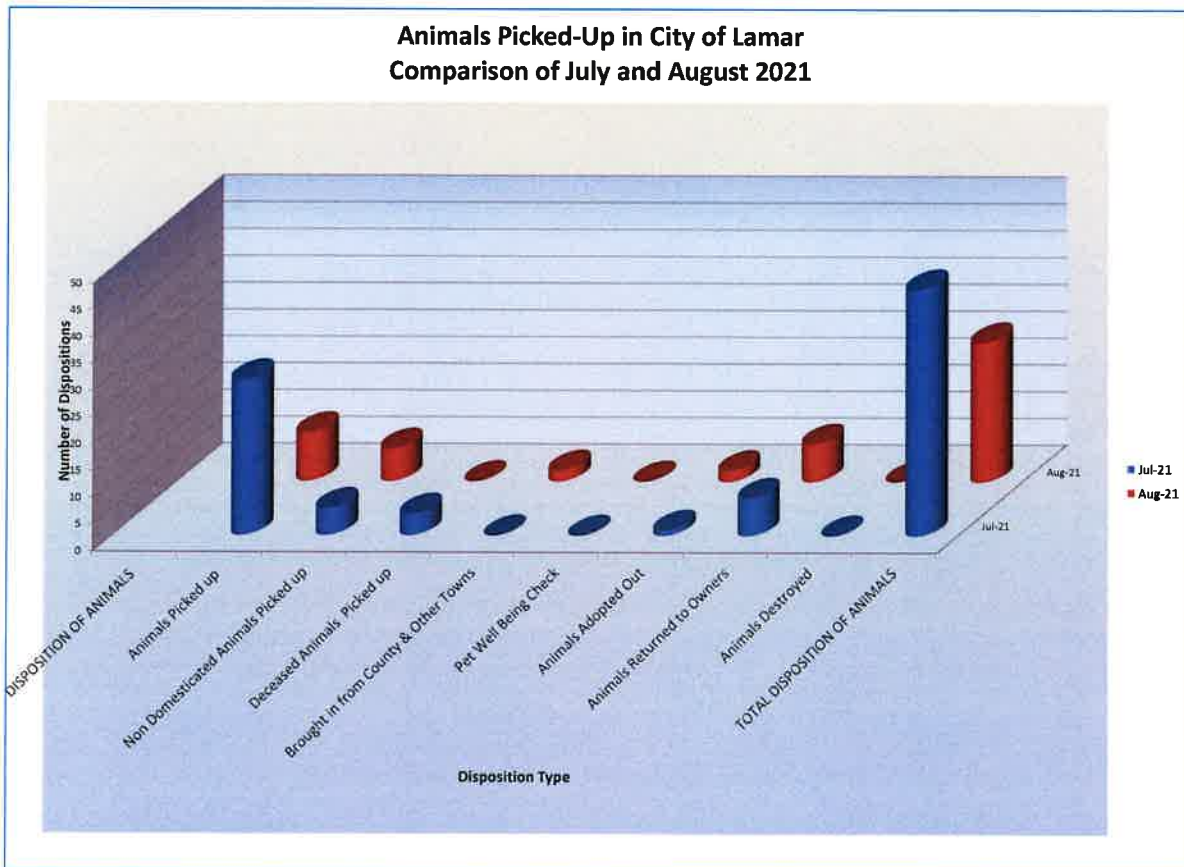

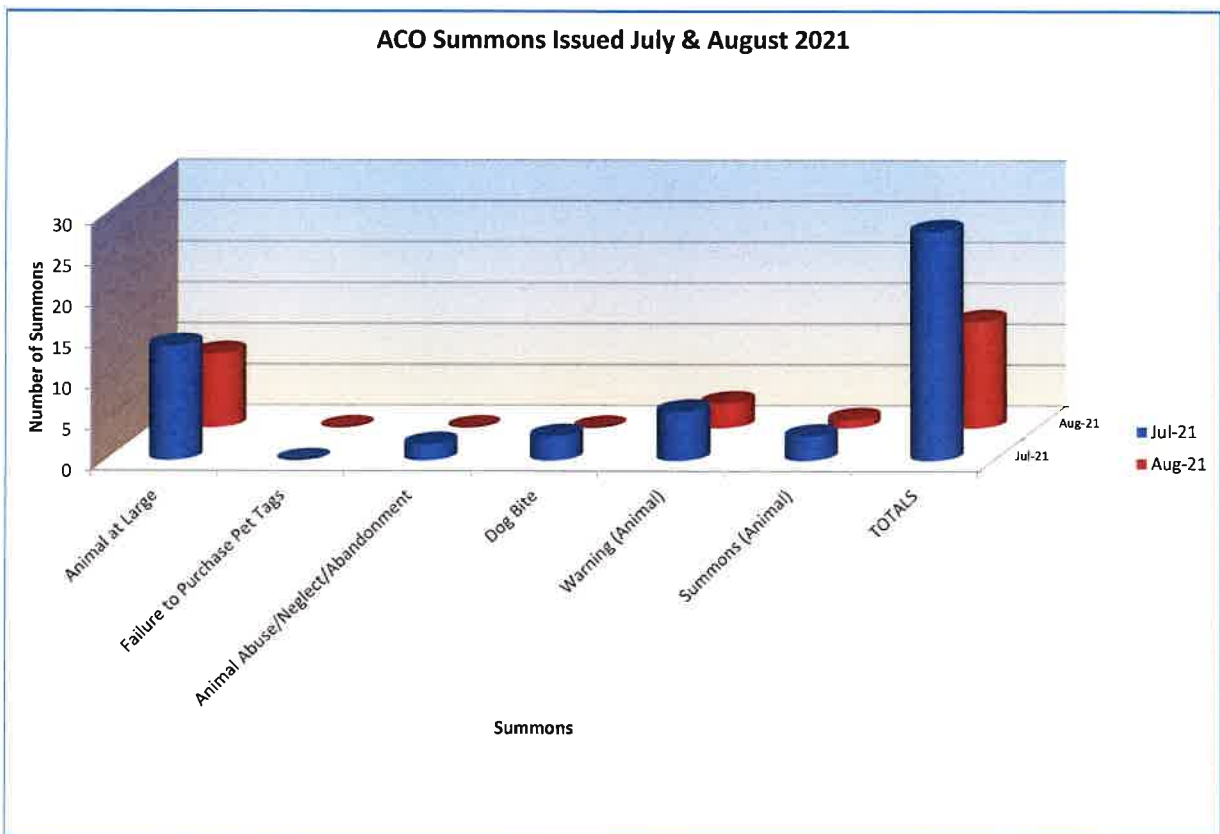
