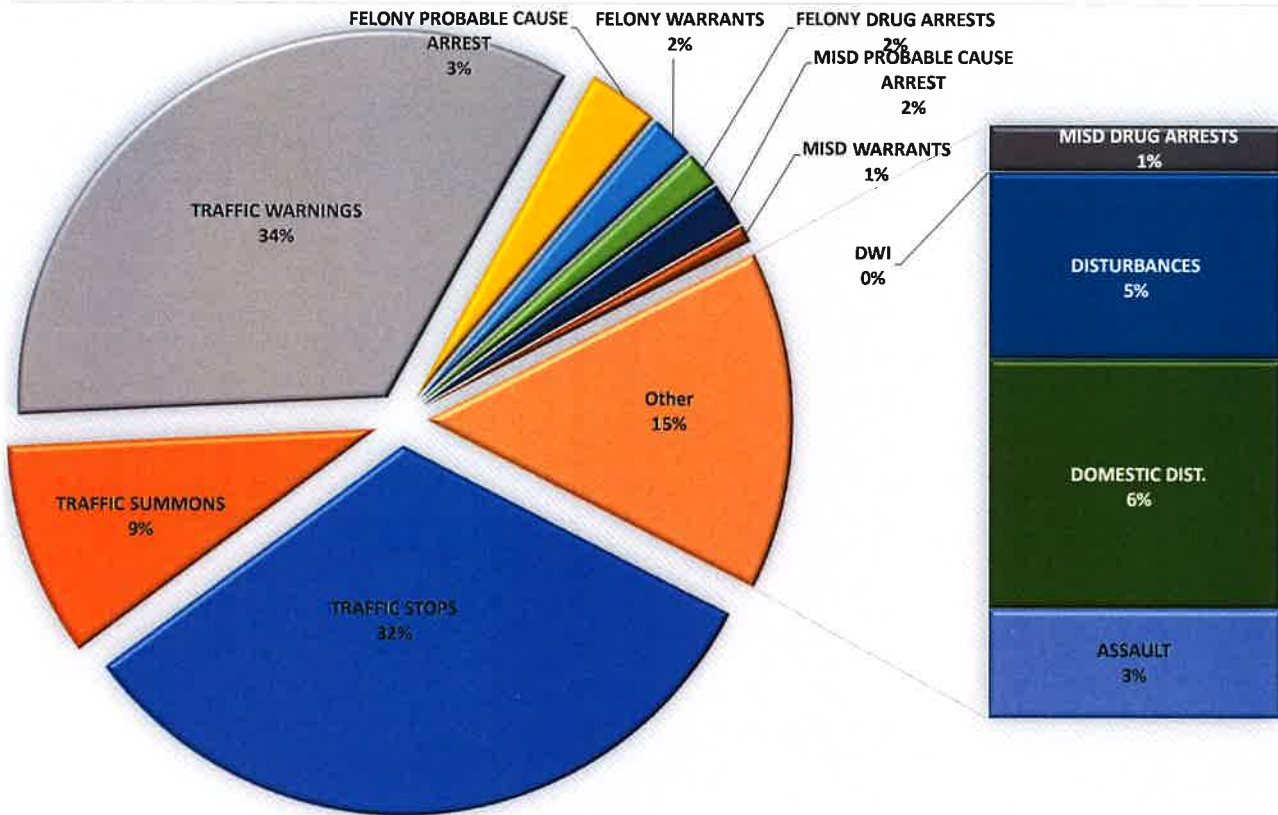

03/09/2022 Officer responded to a report of trespassing. Subject was found to have drugs and paraphernalia in his possession and was transferred to the Barton Count Jail.

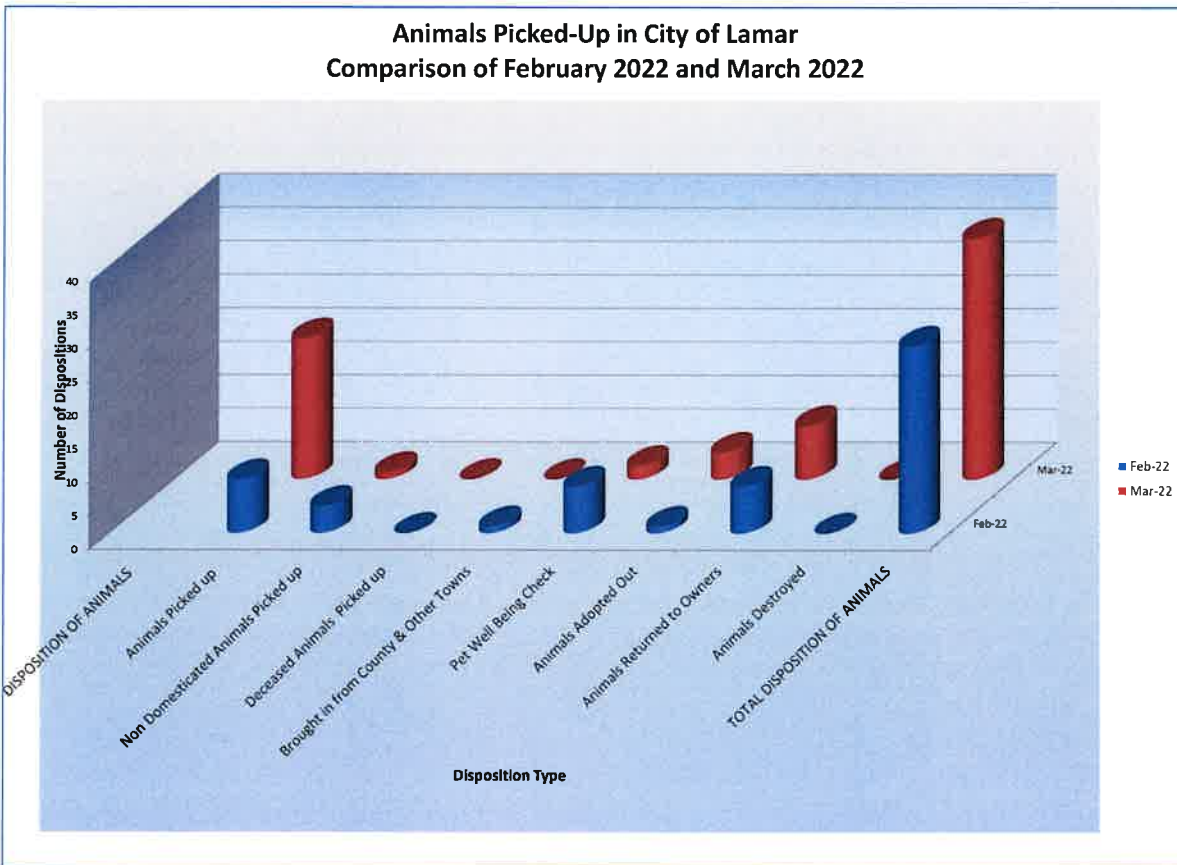
03/10/2022 SRO Robert Lawrence held the 2021-2022 Grade DARE Graduation.

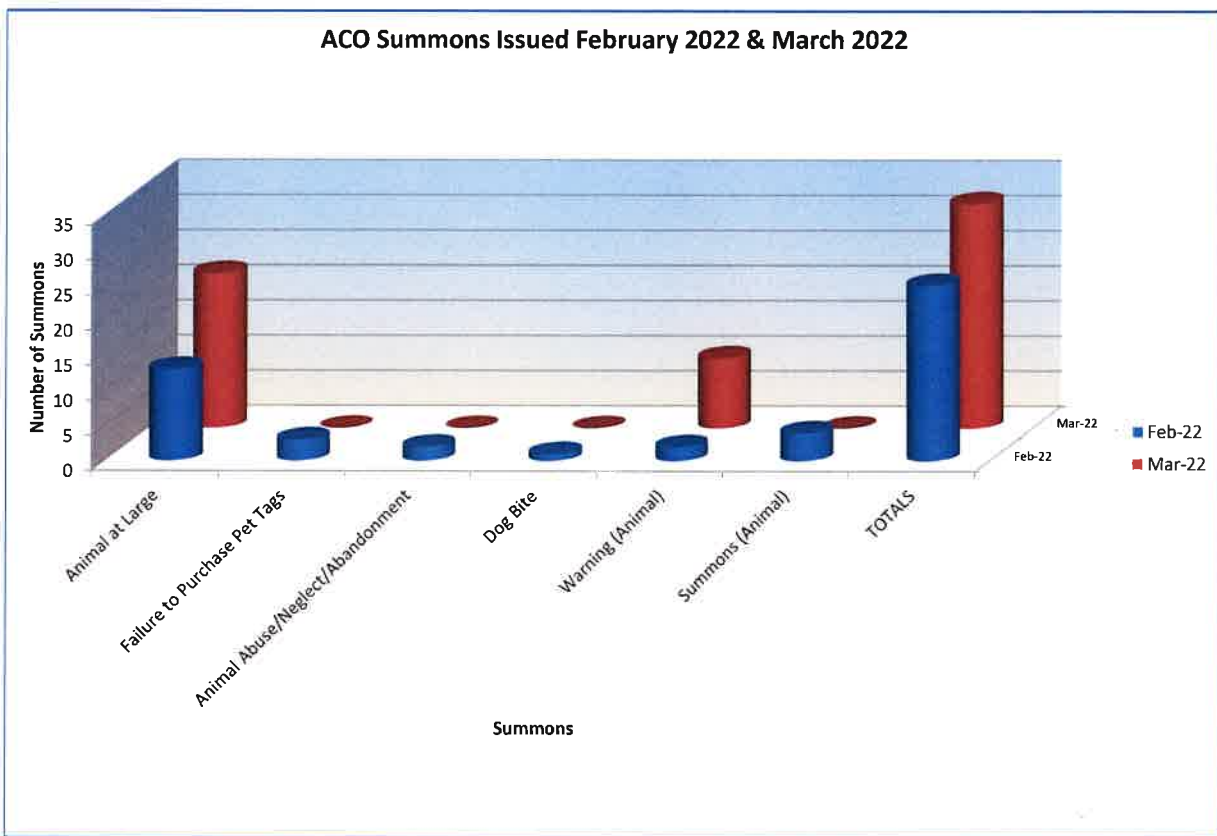
