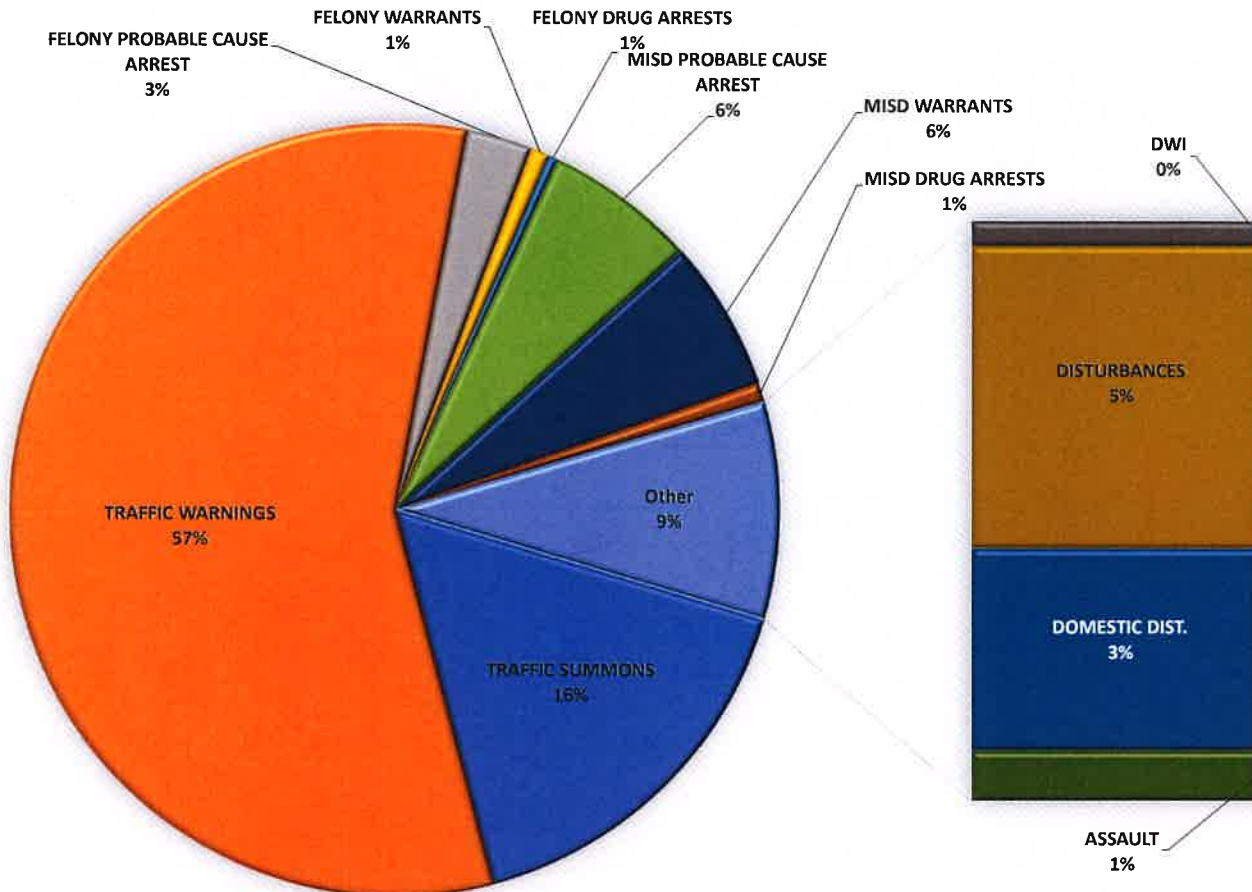

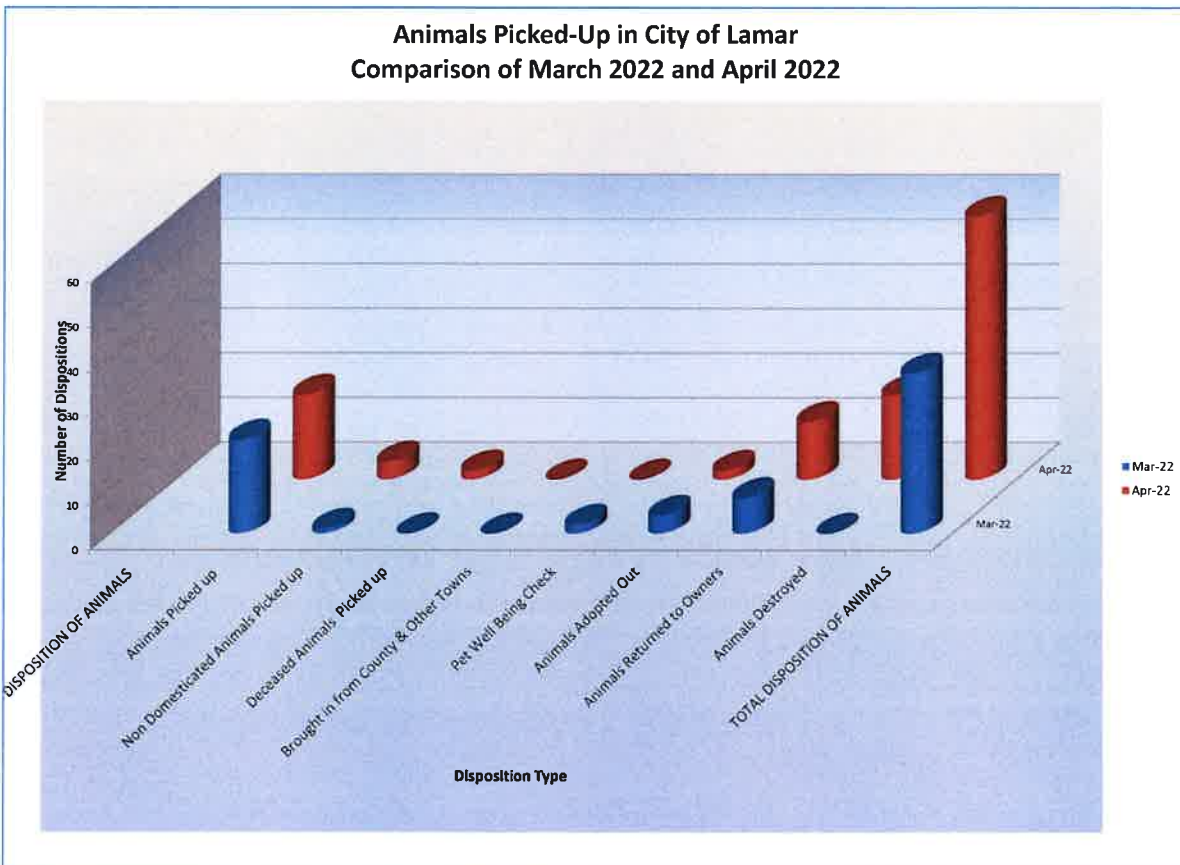
SIGNIFICANT APRIL EVENTS

04/25/2022 Steve Shaw was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant. He will have the responsibilities of the Assistant Chief of Police.

04/06/2022 Officer received a report of a theft from a vehicle. The investigation led to a residence in the 1300 block of College. A search warrant for that residence was obtained. During the execution of the search warrant, another call was received regarding a theft from a vehicle. One person was arrested for obstruction and placed on a 24hr hold for investigation for possession of stolen property. One person was arrested on City warrants. One other was placed on a 24 hour hold for investigation for possession of stolen property. All were transported to the Barton County Jail. Many of the stolen items from both thefts were located during the execution of the search warrant. This led to a total of 5 thefts. Since then, most of the stolen items from all thefts have been found and returned to the owners.

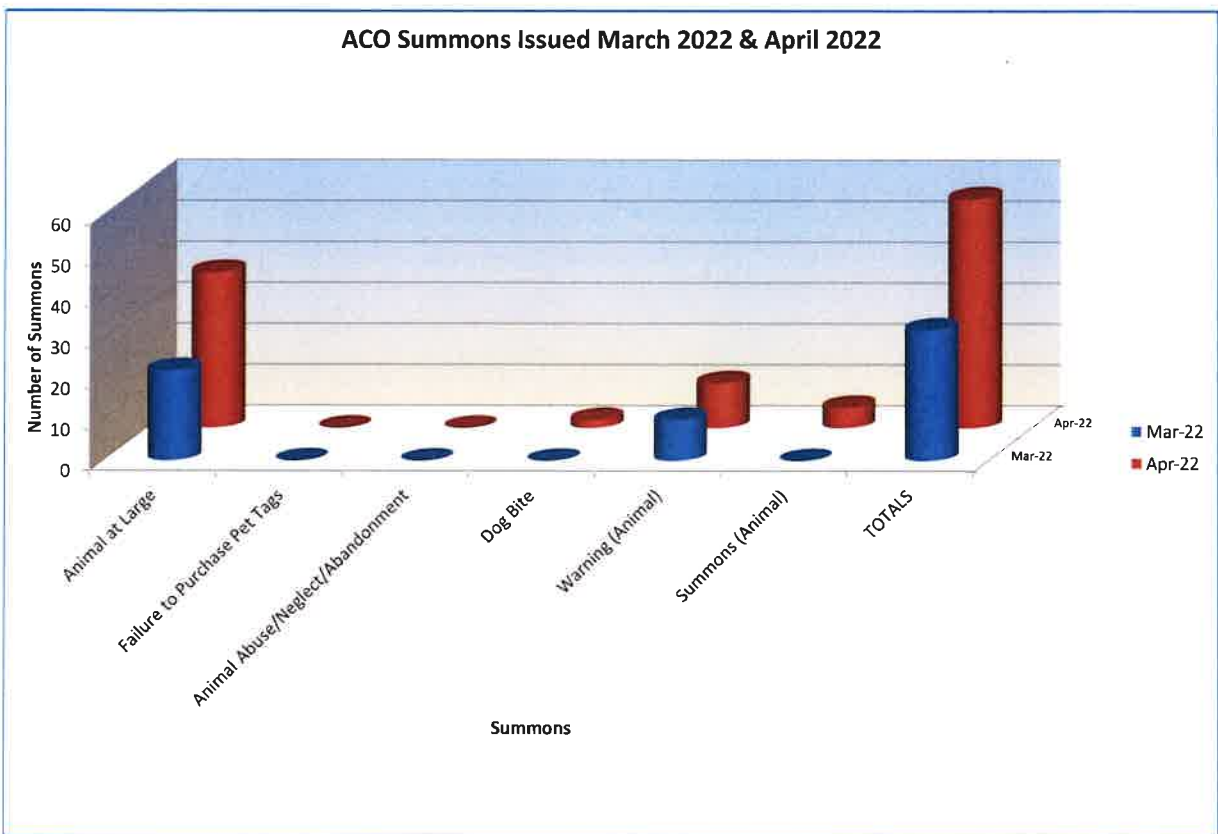
04/24/2022 Officers of the Lamar Police Department assisted members of the Ozark Drug Enforcement Team with serving a search warrant in the 1300 block of Gulf. Several items that had been reported as stolen just a few days before were recovered during this search. The home was posted and condemned as unsafe for human occupancy due to the human waste and the city building inspector was scheduled to inspect the residence the next morning.
