Water & Wastewater Department:

- Drought conditions are causing numerous water leaks.
- Pump #3 repaired at WWTF.
- Pump #2 is down waiting for a gasket set.
- Fire hydrant in front of fire station is complete.

Electrical Department:

- Utility pole replacement project with MPUA RSC - Scheduling
- Finishing upgrades to Lamar Career and Technical Center.
- Utilities Committee recommendation for repairs of Gauscor #4.
- Emissions testing scheduled for July 19th for CAT #2 & Guascor #3.
- Tree trimming around power lines continues.

Street Department:

- Repairing damage to lake dam spill-way concrete.
- Preparing for asphalt overlay project. Tentatively scheduled for 1st week of August.

Water Plant:

- Well Update: Replacement VFD to be delivered July 18th. A deadline extension has been requested from DNR (August 31, 2022)
- Water sample testing will be required before well can become fully operational.
- The wastewater lagoon effluent zinc limits have returned to normal for the second quarter test results.

Parks & Rec:

- Sign-up is open for flag football and soccer.
- Staining wooden bridge at the park and Wheeler.
- Concession stands continue to be vandalized.

New City Hall:

- HVAC work continues.
- Sheetrock finishing has begun.
- Waiting for floor tile for lobby and tile for bathrooms.
